- Achieve effective, streamlined and enhanced service delivery that continues to meet the needs of our community.
- Increased REACH Niagara mobile and indoor clinics by 40%.
- Provided care to 1,800 community members who without REACH Niagara would either neglect their health becoming sicker or would go to the Emergency Department.
- Had positive interactions with community members:
 - 100% felt 'safe' accessing REACH
 - 100% felt their concerns were addressed and treated with importance
 - 100% were 'very satisfied' with REACH services
- Added counselling and system navigation as a service for community members to access.
- Offered a new Substance Use and Addiction Program that saw 92% of clients having less overdoses.
- Expanded the point-of-care services we provide with a new ultrasound machine.
- Expanded the communities we service.
